## Project Description

We were invited to competitive tender for roofing and reinstatement on behalf of Walker Construction, to 3x Landmarc sites. We were successfully appointed to the contract.

The works incorporated the removal of asbestos cement corrugated sheets, and reinstatement with new galvanised corrugated steel sheets, verges and ridges. All guttering was removed and re-fixed in place, with any damaged guttering replaced, and all down pipes replaced.

In addition, at Lower Winterage Farm, we removed all existing roof coverings, re-felt the roof using a breathable membrane, batten, and re-tiled the roof, with access via scaffolding.

Access to the works was via fixed tagged scaffold with a covered temporary scaffold roof to protect from the weather and allow for constant working, and via a boom lift/cherry picker.

Full site specific RAMS were produced and communicated to all relevant parties.
